Phillip's arrangement of "I Love Thee" is not only a wonderful stand alone handbell arrangement, but he has also written a FULL ORCHESTRATION to go along with this piece. We are SO EXCITED about having this new piece for our workshop and for your use.

"I Love Thee" will be utilized at our workshop as the sight reading piece. We would like to ask that you hold off working on this tune until your choir arrives at the workshop. We WILL work on the tune during our mass ring rehearsals as well as playing it together at the end. However, please hold it until the workshop!

Pricing for "I Love Thee":

- Handbell score only: The normal price for the handbell score only is \$4.95, but Phillip is offering our workshop choirs an exclusive special price of \$3.95 per copy that you make for your ringers. That is a 20% "workshop savings" off the normal price.
- Full Orchestration for Handbells and Orchestra: For \$60.00 you may purchase the entire Orchestration for "I Love Thee." This package comes with the handbell score included, as well as the permission rights to make the number of copies you need for your handbell players at no additional charge.

Suggestion on How to Copy the Handbell Score:

So that our page turns with all the choirs at our workshop are consistent, we suggest that you copy the handbell score as follows: Pages 1 and 2 back to back (turn after page 1) / Pages 3 and 4 back to back (turn after page 3) / page 5 alone. This is not a requirement, just a suggestion.
